The Cathedral always provides flowers at the Altar (except during the seasons of Lent and Advent when the altar is not adorned), and they are arranged by the Cathedral Altar Guild. You may make the altar flowers a memorial, and they are then acknowledged in loving memory of the person departed, in the following Sunday's Announcement bulletin. Your generosity in so doing enables us to fund the provision of flowers at the altar during the year. If there is to be an urn of cremated remains, a small vase of flowers at the foot of the table upon which the urn is placed is very fitting. The family may provide this, or the Altar Guild may be able to arrange this for an additional charge.

If personal financial circumstances mean that the above fees cause particular hardship, please speak with your priest.
